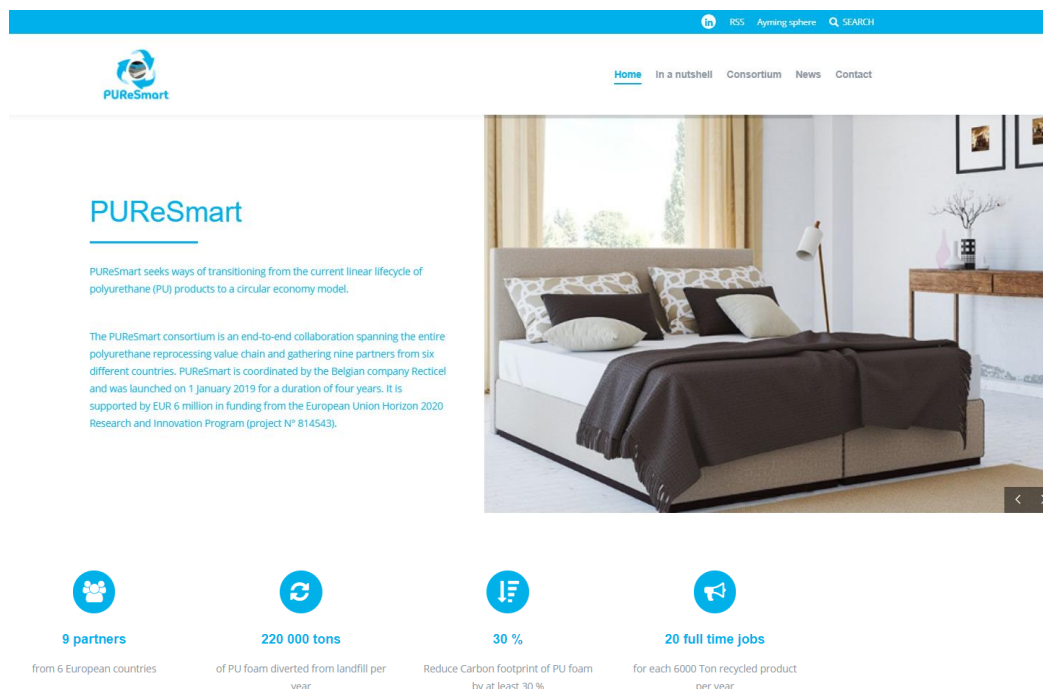

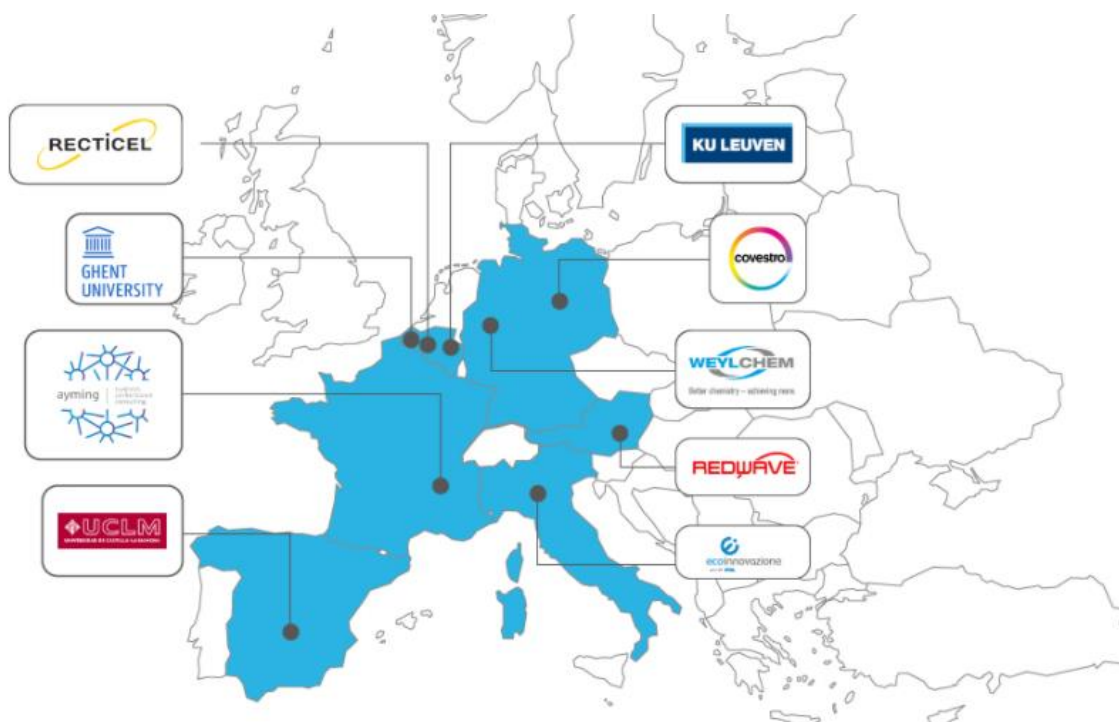

1.3. Maintenance

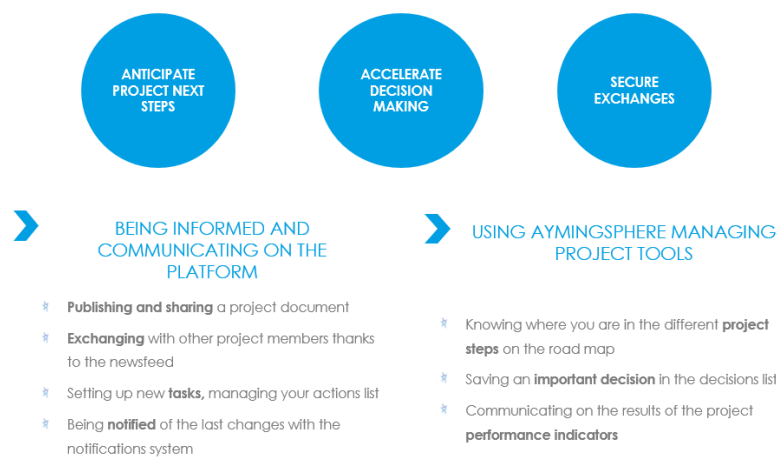
The website was created by a communication agency.
